Come assist us to make and initiate plans to erect W3R-NJ signage along the route through New Jersey and reenactments to commemorate its 226th anniversary in 2007 of the route of General George Washington's Continental Army and the army of Gen. Le Comte de Rochambeau and their return journey in 1782 from York Town, Virginia through the State of New Jersey on the way back to Providence, Rhode Island.

Subsequent to Congress directing the Secretary of the Interior to undertake a Special Resource Study of the **Crossroads of the American Revolution** in central New Jersey in the fiscal year 2000 appropriations bill (P.L. 106-113) which was signed into law 11/29/1999, and New Jersey's Executive Order 116, signed on July 3, 2000, establishing the 225th Anniversary of the American Revolution Celebration Commission in New Jersey to plan promote and coordinate Commemorative programming and activities in New Jersey, The Washington-Rochambeau Revolutionary Route National Heritage Trail Act of 2000 (P.L. 106-473) directed the Secretary of the Interior to undertake a study of the Washington-Rochambeau 1781 march from Newport, Rhode Island to York Town, Virginia.
